GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Students who wish to benefit from the study mobility must be enrolled in an undergraduate program at Ostim Technical University and must be a full-time student for at least one semester in the 2025-2026 academic year in which the mobility will take place (60 ECTS for one academic year, 30 ECTS for one semester (course or non-course obligation), exceptions are handled separately).
- 2. Undergraduate students, excluding first year, first semester and senior students, will be eligible to apply for Student Learning Mobility.
- 3. In order to apply, the GPA must be at least 2.20 at the undergraduate level.
- 4. Applications will be made through the Turkish National Agency Erasmus Application Portal by entering the e-government username-password.
- 5. Within the framework of the budget allocated to our institution, grant support will be provided to a total of 15 students. In order to benefit more students, grant support will be provided to each student for 1 semester.
- 6. The total quota for the Faculty of Engineering is 8, for the Faculty of Architecture 2, and for the Faculty of Economics and Administrative Sciences 5. In case of not getting enough points to enter the ranking, quotas will be transferred between departments.
- 7. Mobility can only be realized in universities and departments with which we have an agreement. If your department does not have an agreement, your application will not be considered. To reach our agreements **CLICK HERE**.
- 8. Being selected as a result of the application does not guarantee your mobility. The institution you have been selected for mobility has the right not to accept you.







- 9. Students who were accepted in the previous semester but failed to realize the mobility cannot be sent directly to the following year. Since mobility announcements are valid for mobility that must be completed within a certain period of time, applying to previous announcements and passing the selection cannot be considered as a "vested right". Students in this situation must make a new application.
- 10. All eligible students, regardless of whether they are citizens of the Republic of Turkey or citizens of other countries, can apply for the activity specified in this announcement. There is no restriction for foreign students to benefit from mobility within the framework of the Erasmus+ Program.
- 11. The possible period for Erasmus+ Student Learning Mobility activities for the academic year 2025-2026, which is opened for application with this announcement, covers the period from September 01, 2025 to February 28, 2026. Student learning mobility activities must be started no later than October 15, 2025 and in any case all mobility activities must be completed no later than February 28, 2026.
- 12. Foreign Students: "T.C. Residence Permit Certificate" and the part of your passport containing personal information must be uploaded to the application page. Those whose residence permit period is between 01.09.2025-28.02.2026 can apply. Upload the Residence Permit Document as a PDF file with the front and back side as a single file. Please upload the relevant page of your passport as a separate PDF file.
- 13. If students return before the minimum period (2 months) is completed, the activity will be deemed invalid and any grant prepayment made to the student will be refunded.
- 14. In case of not participating in the mobility without submitting a waiver notification in due time even though selected for the Learning Mobility, in cases other than force majeure (not being able to obtain a visa, etc.), minus points will be applied in case of applying for the next Erasmus mobility.







APPLICATION EVALUATION CRITERIA

• The evaluation will be based on scoring. Scoring will be made out of a total of "100" and the following evaluation criteria and weighted scores will be used:

Academic achievement level (according to 100 point system)	%50
Language level	%50
For children of martyrs and veterans	+15 points
Disabled students (provided that the disability is documented)	+10 points
Previous utilization (with or without grant)	-10 points
Participation in mobility in the country of citizenship	-10 points
For students who have been granted protection, care or shelter under the Social Services Law No. 2828	+10 points
Applying for both study and internship at the same time (for the mobility of the student's choice)	-10 points
Failure to participate in the mobility without submitting a waiver notification in due time (applied if the student reapplies to Erasmus)	-10 points
Those who themselves or their 1st degree relatives receive disaster victim assistance from AFAD	+10 points
For students selected for mobility: Failure to attend meetings/trainings organized by the higher education institution regarding mobility without an excuse (applicable if the student re-applies to Erasmus).	-5 points
Failure to take the language exam without an excuse (applied if the student reapplies to Erasmus)	-5 points

- In the list to be formed as a result of the final evaluation, each student is subjected to a point
 ranking according to the applicants from their department. If there are applicants with equal
 points in the same department, the student with the higher academic achievement grade is
 given priority, and if the academic achievement grade is equal, the student with the younger
 age is given priority.
- The application evaluation criteria are based on the Handbook on the Implementation of Student and Staff Mobility in Higher Education between Program Countries and Partner Countries for 2024.







FOREIGN LANGUAGE

- 1. Students who will participate in Erasmus Study Mobility are required to apply with Foreign Language exam results during their application. Students are required to apply with the results of the Proficiency Exam, TOEFL previously organized by our university. In the Foreign Language Exam, Reading/Language Usage, Listening and Writing skills are measured. (Preparatory skipping exams are not valid)
- 2. In order to participate in the mobility, all undergraduate students must have a minimum foreign language score of 60 points.
- 3. Students who do not get enough points in the language exam conducted by our institution will not be evaluated.
- 4. The results of the Foreign Language exams held on 04 April 2023, 20-27 September 2023 and 18-20 September 2024 organized by our institution (School of Foreign Languages) will be accepted in this application period. Applications can be made with existing scores.

GRANT

It is essential that students who will participate in Erasmus Study Mobility are given monthly financial support for the time they spend abroad.

The grant payment is made in two stages. As the first payment, 80% of the total grant amount is transferred to the student's account before departure and the remaining 20% as the final payment is transferred to the student's account upon return.

Students who cannot be allocated a grant can choose to give up their right to participate in the program or choose to participate with "0 grant".

The table of individual support grant amounts to be applied to students in the program countries is given below.

- 1. For students who are eligible to participate in the grant-funded study mobility, a maximum grant of 150 days will be given to students who will go for one semester. Students whose mobility ends below these periods will be given grants according to their mobility period. The beginning of the mobility period starts with the beginning of the academic calendar and ends with the final deadline.
- 2. Students who do not complete the participant questionnaire, except for technical reasons, will receive a deduction of 20% of the total final grant..
- 3. The grants of unsuccessful students are deducted at a rate of 5%-25% depending on the credit load taken, but not less than 5%.
- 4. If the documents proving participation in the mobility are not submitted, the mobility will be deemed invalid and the student will not be paid a grant; the grant initially paid will be refunded.
- 5. Additional Grant Support Criteria Document: Please prove this with an official document by uploading it to the application system during your application. Otherwise, unfortunately, this situation cannot be taken into consideration.
- 6. Participants with special needs and disadvantaged participants may be eligible for Additional Grant Support in addition to the eligible grant. Student mobility between 2-12 months: Additional grant support of €250 per month is available.
